We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in the game. Parent's, carers and spectator's expectations and attitudes have a significant bearing on a child's attitude towards:

- Other Players
- Referees
- Team Officials
- Spectators

LM Premier Coaching is supporting The Respect Group to ensure soccer can be enjoyed in a safe, positive environment. Remember children's soccer is a time for them to develop their Technical, physical, tactical and social skills. Winning isn't everything.

Play your part and observe LM Premier Coaching's Code of Conduct for Parents, Carers and Spectators and at all times:

- Remember that children play for FUN
- Applaud effort and good play as well as success
- Always respect the match officials' decisions
- Remain outside the field of play and within the Designated Spectators' Area (where provided)
- Let the team official do their job and not confuse the players by telling them what to do
- Encourage the players to respect the opposition, referee and match officials
- Avoid criticizing a player for making a mistake – mistakes are part of learning
- Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting, or abusive language or behaviour.

**Understand that if you do not follow the Code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by LM Premier Coaching, I may be:**

- Issued with a verbal warning from the organization
- Required to meet with the owners
- Obligated to leave the venue by the coach
- Requested by the Head of operations not to attend future games
